Layla and Megan are playing with the water gutters and trough.

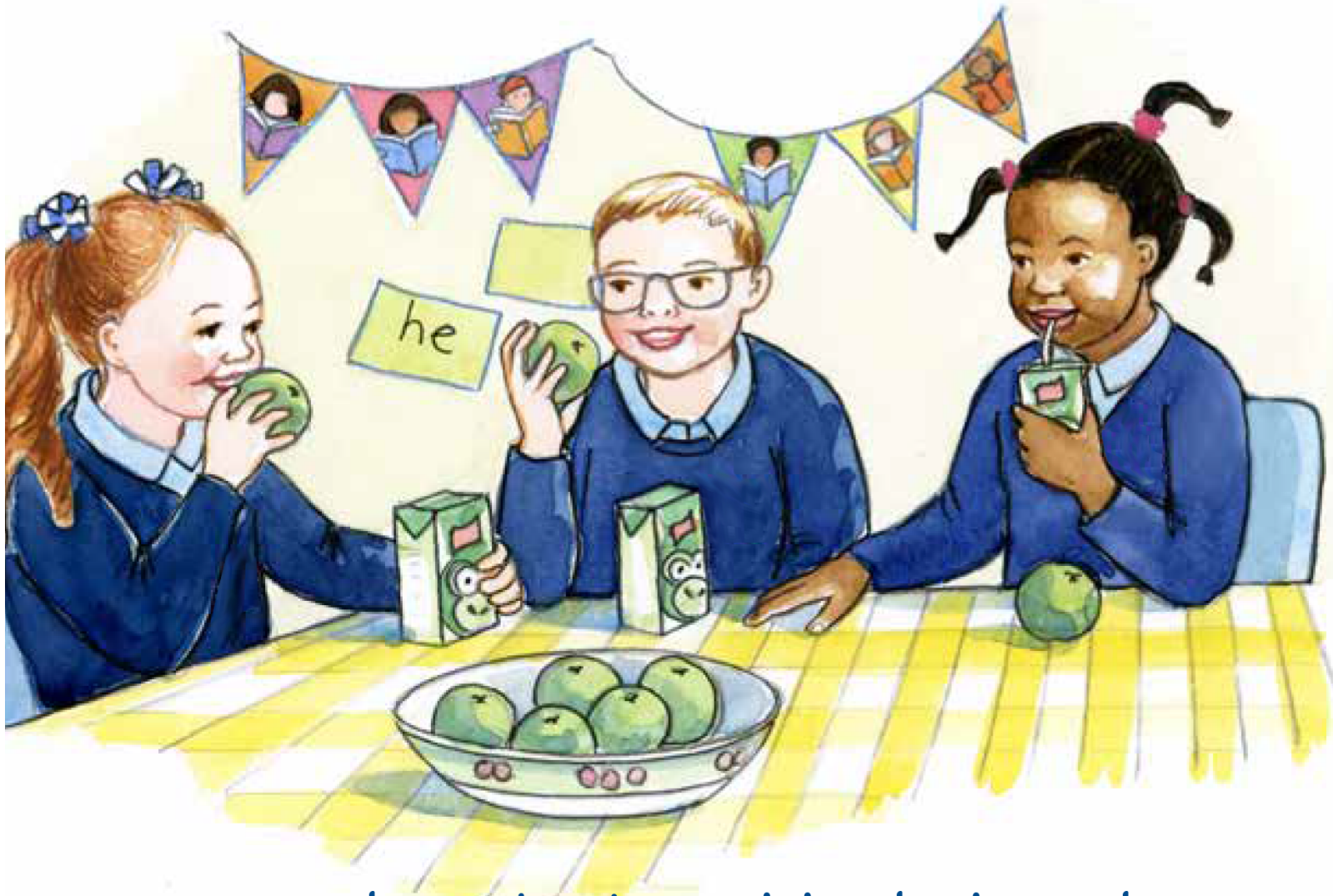
**“Don’t splash me!”** Layla tells Megan as she pours water into Layla’s jug.

Megan, Matthew and Layla are sitting chatting as they enjoy their morning snack.

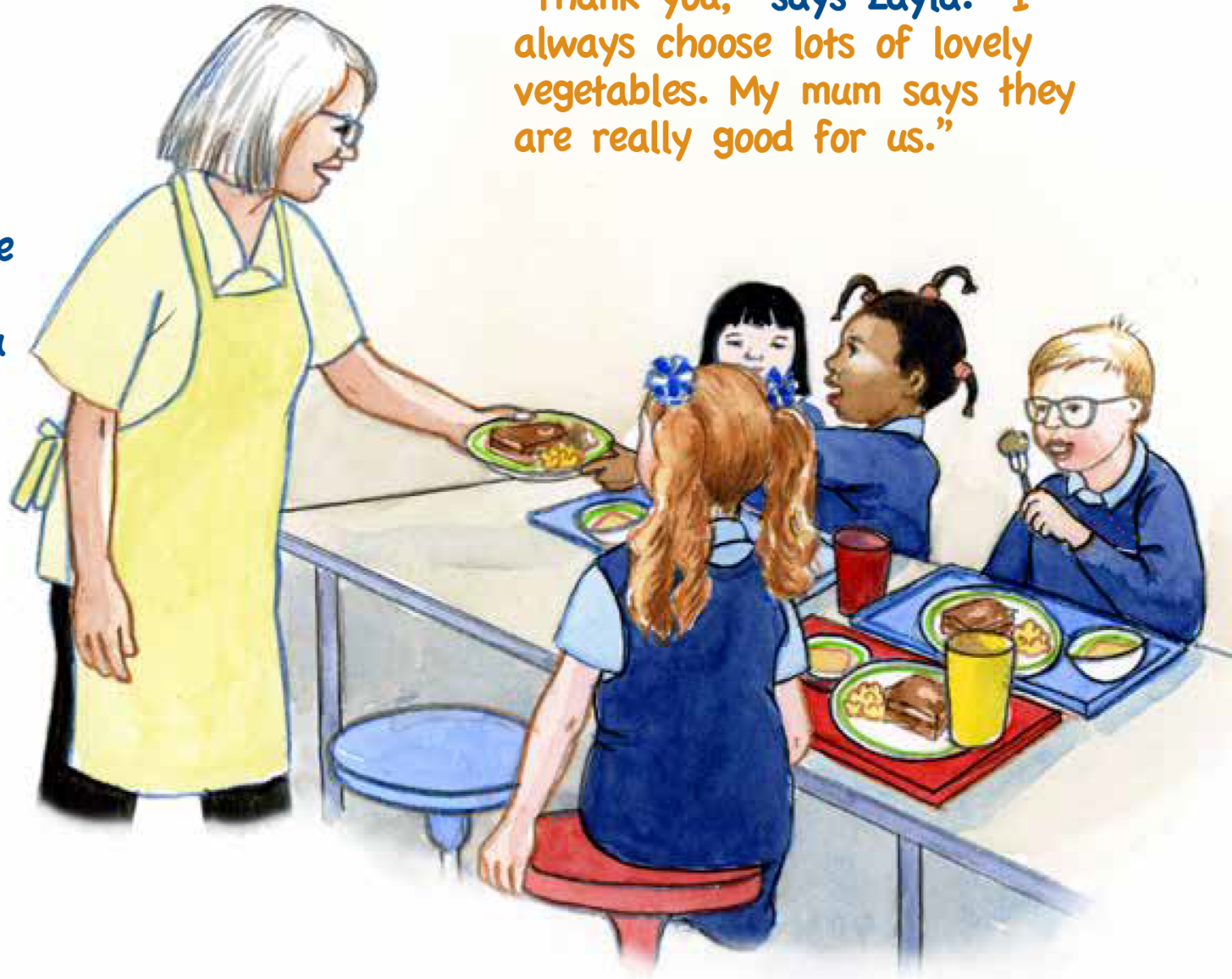
“We love apples,” say Megan and Matthew at the same time and they all laugh!

them.

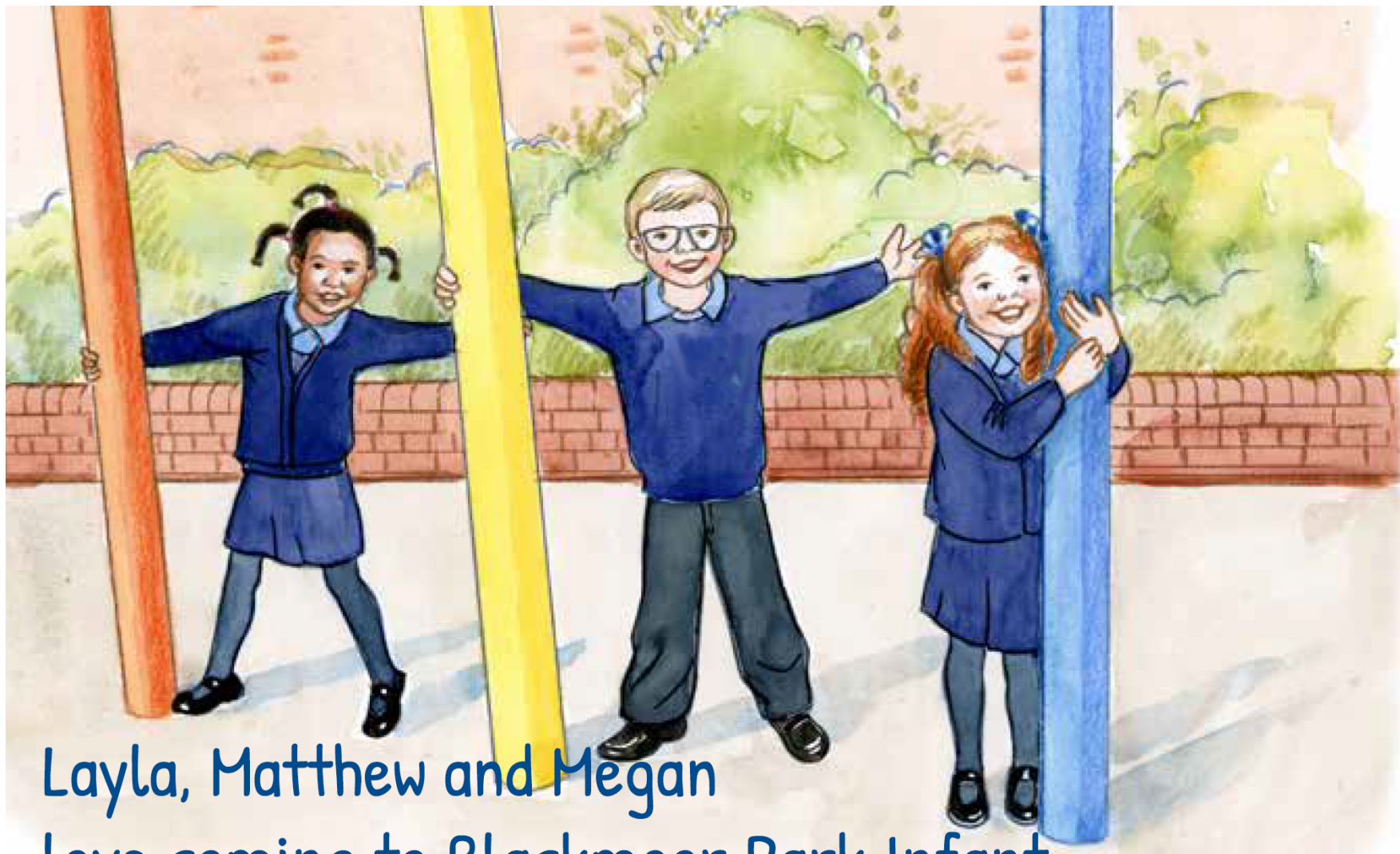
The teacher has seen
